

Carer's Benchmark Rates

Level 1 — from \$30/hr

Experience & Qualifications:

- 2–4 years' experience
- May hold a Certificate III or be currently studying
- Mandatory checks: WWCC, Police Check, First Aid/CPR

Families can expect:

- Safe, consistent daily care
- Age-appropriate play and gentle guidance
- Support with routines and transitions

Level 2 — from \$35/hr

Experience & Qualifications:

- 4+ years' experience OR holds a Certificate
 III or Diploma with strong experience
- May have child-related training (e.g., safe sleep, routines, behaviour guidance, inclusive practices)

Families can expect:

- Confident support with a range of ages
- Strong routine management and communication
- Age-appropriate play and simple learning activities

Level 3 — from \$40/hr

Experience & Qualifications:

- 7+ years' experience OR Diploma/ECT with significant experience
- May have additional training (e.g. in infant care support, neurodiversity/ inclusion, or early childhood development)

Families can expect:

- Skilled infant care and confident management of multiple children
- Practical developmental support (early learning, social-emotional skills, school readiness)
- High levels of professionalism and independence

Level 4 — from \$45/hr

Experience & Qualifications:

- 10+ years' experience or ECT qualification or higher with significant experience
- May have specialised training or experience supporting children with disabilities or additional needs

Families can expect:

- High-level developmental support and structured learning
- Leadership in routines, boundaries, and wellbeing
- Where relevant, more specialised care for children with special needs or disabilities

Professional Statement: Rates reflect a carer's verified experience, qualifications, professional expectations, and level of responsibility. These minimums ensure fairness, industry alignment, and high-quality care for families.
